Mohsin Y. K. Yousufi is a civic technologist and currently a PhD candidate in Digital Media at Georgia Institute of Technology, researching the intersection of civic technology, collective intelligence systems, and epistemic injustices. Drawing from Human-Computer Interaction, Computer Science, and design research, he develops innovative knowledge infrastructures that empower communities to pursue effective collective action and self-governance. Using both empirical and applied research methods, he is broadly interested in the nature of civic collective action and currently focuses on addressing epistemic breakdowns in civic sociotechnical systems. Through his work, he seeks to understand and mend the fractures in public discourse and civic engagement that are often amplified by technology.

Mohsin's multidisciplinary approach encompasses qualitative and quantitative methods, as well as the development of technical solutions, enabling him to examine complex civic challenges from both theoretical and practical perspectives. Mohsin is an alumnus of Harvard's Berkman Klein Center and Harvard metaLAB. He was also a Fulbright Scholar. His research has been featured at prestigious venues, including NeurIPS, ACM CSCW, ACM CHI, ACM DIS, Society for Social Studies of Science (4S), and the Smithsonian National Museum of American History.
